# International student groups in Birmingham during I-STEP training week

Students from Ireland, The Netherlands, The United Kingdom and Lithuania took part in a week long training programme on international entrepreneurship in Birmingham, UK. Hosted by the UK partner, Bridging to the Future, the students pilot tested the I-STEP materials and platform. During the week, partners organised several workshops to work on the different I-STEP modules.

Melanie Doherty, Year 1 Accounting student, about the activity from module 1 International Opportunities: 'I really enjoyed this activity, it was very fun and creative. We brought together what seemed like two impossible businesses and proposed how they would work together, showing that anything can work if you are open minded and have a great strategy.'



The aim of this week was to help further test the materials that have been developed thus far in a practical training setting. A key element of the week in Birmingham was the formation of international business teams whereby one student from each country came together to work on a business idea, which culminated in a "Dragons' Den" style pitch to find the best idea.




