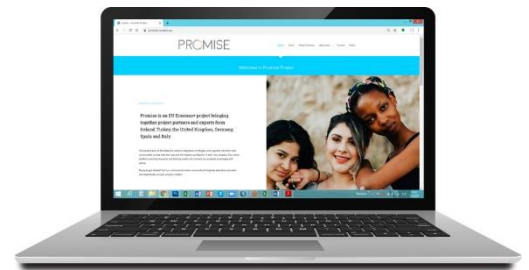
“Promoting Refugee & Migrant Integration through Education (PROMISE)”

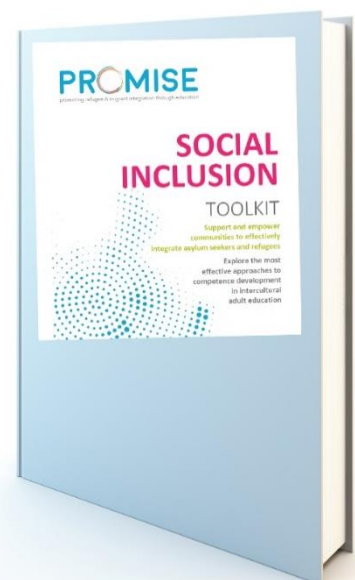
Updated Social Inclusion Toolkit:

THE IMPACT OF COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

On project meeting, the training event and the multiplier events

Due to the Coronavirus outbreak in Europe, restrictions and precautions have been implemented by the governments of partner countries including the Irish NA. Rescheduled Skills Accelerator learning activity via virtual mechanism

After completing the IOs, we will use them to deliver the Skills Accelerator learning activity in autumn 2020. This will enable us to prepare the first generation of

educators to employ the PROMISE framework. These participants will ascertain an important role as project ambassadors participating in multiplier events, fulfilling wider dissemination efforts and maximising sustainability overall.

Each partner will organize an online multiplier event in the near future for target audiences in their region. The showcase will highlight the role of interagency networks, help you to understand the value of the OERs while encouraging participants to either integrate the framework and IOs into their ongoing work, or use their position
