

ERASMI Third Transnational online Meeting 9th December 2020



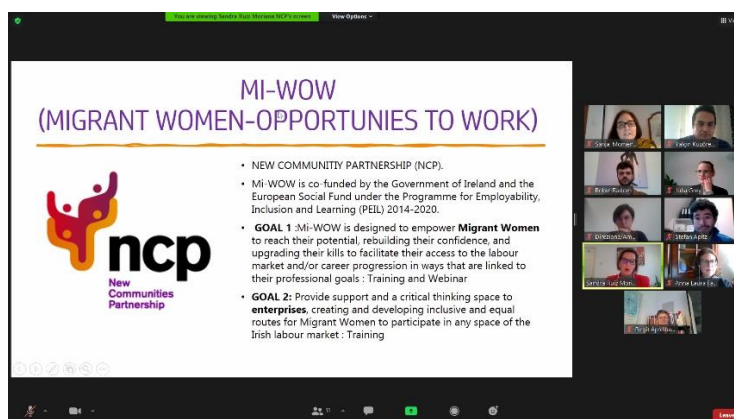
The Third Transnational Meeting of the ERASMI project took place on 09 December 2020. Due to COVID-19 the partners from Germany, Turkey, Italy, Ireland and Denmark did not meet as planned in Leitrim in Ireland but online in a Zoom conference. In spite of the format limitations our project activities can only be described as having been very productive.

The Harz University team gave an overview of the project and of the Good Practices Compendium, as result of IO1, which at the current date has just to be translated in Italian and Turkish.

Momentum shared Interim Evaluation Conclusions, incorporating the Year One Overview Report, which highlighted:

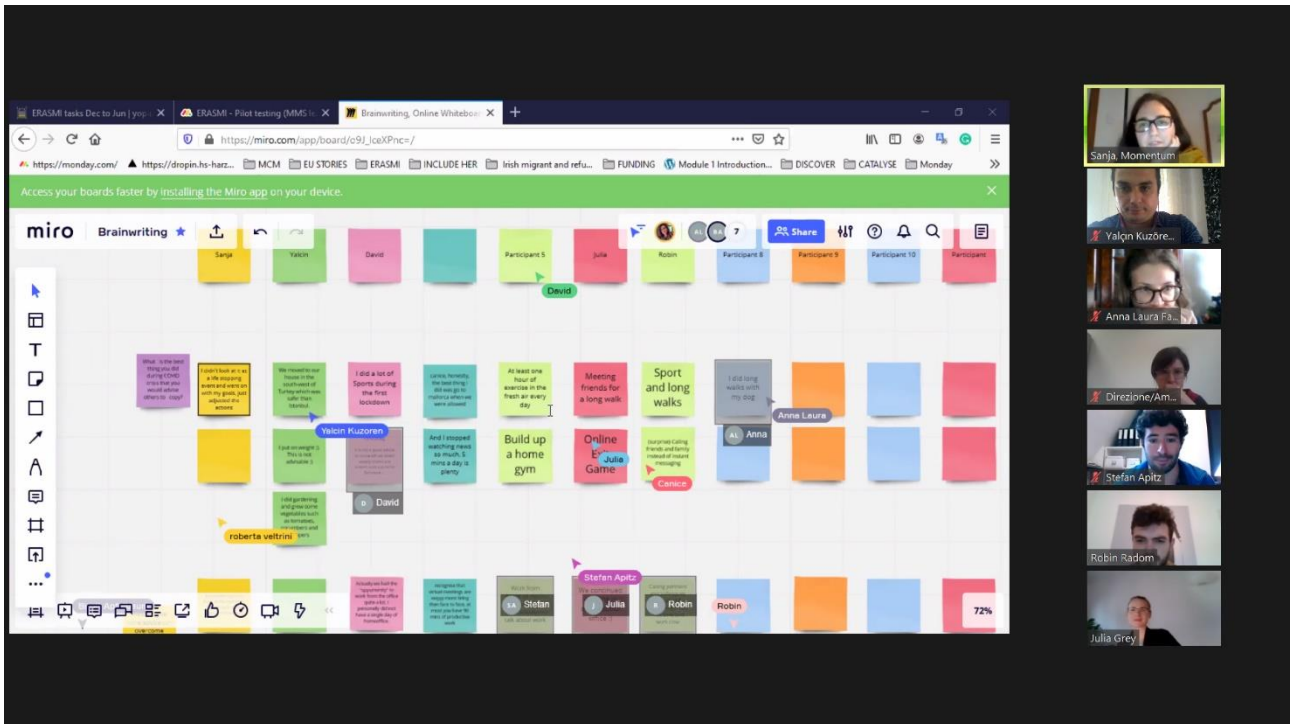
- a very good quality of IOs products;
- an excellent project management;
- an excellent communication between the Project's partners.

Momentum also invited to the meeting a guest speaker, **Sandra Ruiz Moriana from NCP** who presented her experience as a migrant in Ireland and **Mi-WOW**, a project to give support to migrant women.



The partners discussed about the current status of IO2 (ERASMI Multi-Actor Inclusion Toolkit) and IO3 (ERASMI Inter-Agency Networks and Action Plans) and EUEI kicked off the fourth Project's Output (ERASMI Knowledge Exchange Platform and OERs).

During the 3rd Transnational Meeting, the ERASMI Project partners were also involved in an interactive activity on Miro, coordinated by Momentum, about **the overcome challenges of remote work during COVID-19 crisis**.
